Gavin Wakefield



Gavin is the Director of Training for Missional Ministry for the Diocese of York. He leads the Diocesan Training Team in its work of developing the formation of lay and clergy people. His previous role was at Cranmer Hall, Durham for over 10 years, as Deputy Warden and the mission tutor. Before that he

was in parish ministry in the dioceses of Sheffield and Chelmsford, including a spell church planting in a former mining area. Until recently he was an assistant curate in the Stamford Bridge Group, but has now moved to St Hilda's Tang Hall, with his wife Revd Fran Wakefield, the new priest-in-charge there.

His academic interests are mainly in the area of missiology and include knotty issues in evangelism, the origins of Pentecostalism in the UK, leadership in the church and the development of mission in the north east of England.

He has published a Grove book reflecting on the Pastoral Rule: The Wise Pastor: Learning from Gregory the Great's "Pastoral Rule". All retreatants will be given a copy, along with short extracts from a recent translation of the Latin text.

Who are you?

The Christian tradition is packed with great riches of reflection and examples we can still learn from. One text, of great influence in the past but less well-known now, is the Pastoral Rule of Pope Gregory the Great. Gregory, who initiated a renewed mission to England in the late 6th century, was concerned to raise the standard of parish clergy and to offer practical advice. This wonderful book is full of insight on the character and behaviour of those called to public ministry, as well as providing the most detailed advice from the early years of the Church on how to give spiritual guidance to all kinds of people.
