



Generous Giving and Stewardship Bible Passages : Gospel

VERSE	KEY POINTS
MATTHEW 6.1-4	Beware of practicing your piety before others; when you give, do not let your left hand know what your right is doing; your Father who sees in secret will reward you.
MATTHEW 6.19-34	Do not store up treasures on earth; where your treasure is there your heart will be also; you cannot serve both God and wealth; strive first for the kingdom of God.
MATTHEW 19.16-23	What good deed must I do to have eternal life? Commandments; sell your possessions and follow me; easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of heaven.
MARK 12.41-44	Rich people put in large sums, poor widow two copper coins; widow gave more, put in everything she had to live on.
LUKE 6.32-38	Love your enemies, do good, and lend expecting nothing in return; your reward will be great; give and it will be given to you; the measure you give will be the measure you get back.
LUKE 12.32-34	Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom; make purses for yourselves that do not wear out; unending treasure in heaven; where your treasure is there your heart will be also.
LUKE 18.9-14	Pharisee and tax-collector; tax collector saying 'be merciful to me, a sinner'; all who humble themselves will be exalted.
LUKE 18.15-17	Bringing infants to Jesus; such as these that the kingdom of God belongs.
JOHN 10.8-18	I came so they may have life, and have it abundantly; the good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep; I lay it down of my own accord.

Generous Giving and Stewardship Bible Passages: New Testament

VERSE	KEY POINTS
ROMANS 13.8-14	Owe no one anything except love to one another; love is fulfilling the law; lay aside the works of darkness and put on the armour of light; let us live honourably; put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh to gratify its desires.
HEBREWS 13.1-6	Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, some have entertained angels without knowing it; keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have.
I CHRONICLES 29.10-16	For all that is in the heavens and on the earth is yours; yours is the kingdom; all things come from you, and of your own have we given you.
PHILIPPIANS 4.4-9	Rejoice in the Lord always; do not worry about anything, but pray; God will guard your hearts and minds.
2 CORINTHIANS 9.6-15	One who sows bountifully also reaps bountifully; God loves a cheerful giver; you may share abundantly in every good work; you will be enriched in every way for your great generosity.
I TIMOTHY 6.6-12	Great gain in godliness combined with contentment; we brought nothing into the world so that we can take nothing out of it; love of money is the root of all kinds of evil; pursue righteousness.
I TIMOTHY 6.17-19	Those in the present age who are rich set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, rather than on God who richly provides; they are to be generous and ready to share; take hold of the life that really is life.
ACTS 20.32-35	Commend you to the message of God's grace; build you up; it is more blessed to give than to receive.
GALATIANS 5.16-25	Live by the Spirit; fruits of the Spirit; let us be guided by the Spirit.
I JOHN 2.3-6	Obey his commandments; truly in this person the love of God has reached perfection; 'I abide in him' ought to walk as he walked.
ACTS 2.42-47	All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their possessions and distribute the proceeds to all as any had need; ate their food with glad and generous hearts.
JAMES 1.12-18	Blessed is anyone who endures temptation; every generous act of giving, with every perfect gift, is from above; we would become first fruits of his creatures.

Generous Giving and Stewardship Bible Passages: Old Testament

VERSE	KEY POINTS
MALACHI 3.6-12	I the Lord do not change; bring the full tithe to the storehouse; pour down for you an overflowing blessing; you will be in a land of delight.
PROVERBS 13.6-11	Some pretend to be rich but they have nothing, others tend to be poor but have great wealth; wisdom is with those who take advice; wealth hastily gained will dwindle, but those who gather little by little will increase it.
GENESIS 12.1-5	I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
EXODUS 35.20-29	Everyone whose heart was stirred, whose spirit was willing, brought the Lord's offering for the tent of meeting and all its service.
2 SAMUEL 24.21- END	King David to buy the threshing-floor in order to build an altar; Araunah gives to the king; I will not offer burnt-offerings to the Lord which cost me nothing.
DEUTERONOMY 26.1-11	Take some of the first fruits, which you harvest from the land God has given you; you shall make this response before the Lord your God; celebrate with all the bounty that the Lord has given you.
ISAIAH 58.6-12	Share your bread with the hungry, bring the homeless poor into your house; then your light shall break forth like the dawn; the Lord will satisfy your needs; whose waters never fail.
GENESIS 1.20-27	God created living creatures; make humankind in God's image, let them have dominion over all creature.



Generous Giving and Stewardship Bible Passages: Psalms

VERSE	KEY POINTS
PSALM 8	When I consider your heavens, the works of fingers, the moon and the stars that you have ordained; you have given mortals dominion over the works of your hands.
PSALM 24	The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it; those who have pure hearts will receive blessings.
PSALM 37.16-22	Better is a little that the righteous person has than the abundance of the wicked; the righteous are generous and keep giving.
PSALM 51.10-19	Create in me a clean heart; open my lips and my mouth will declare your praise; the sacrifice acceptable to God is a broken and contrite heart; do good, rebuild the walls of Jerusalem; you will delight in right sacrifices.
PSALM 65	Praise is due to you; the gates of the morning and evening sing your praise; you visit the earth and water it, you make it very plenteous; you crown the year with your goodness.
PSALM 95.1-7	In his hands are the depths of the earth, the heights of the mountains are his also; the sea is his, for he made it, and his hands have moulded the dry land; come let us worship and bow down and kneel before the Lord our maker.
PSALM 104.24-END	How manifold are your works; look to you to give them their food; they are filled with good things; I will sing to the Lord as long as I live.
PSALM 112	Rise in the darkness as a light for the upright; it is well with those who deal generously; they have distributed freely, they have given to the poor; their righteousness endures forever.
