7. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio: **The**Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish in which the school is situated..

• The Lady Elizabeth Hastings Trust in respect of 3 governors.

(b) The Archdeacon of York shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in

the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the

office named in 7 (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is

unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or where there is a vacancy in the

office by virtue of which his or her governorship exists.

8. The Archdeacon of York is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation

governor and to appoint a substitute governor.

9. There is a Trust for the school, supported by a Trust Deed dated 26 March 1986.

10. The ethos of the school is as follows:

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its

religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and

in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest

quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an

understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian

values through the experience it offers to all its pupils"

10. This Instrument comes into effect on 31 August 2015

11. This Instrument was made by order of Leeds City Council Local Education Authority on

3 July 2015.

(and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious

body.
