INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the federation is **The Heritage Coast Primary Church of England Federation**
2. The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name	Category
1. Fylingdales CE VC Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
2. Hawsker-Cum-Stainsacre VC Primary School	Voluntary Controlled

3. The name of the governing body is: **"The Governing Body of The Heritage Coast Primary Church of England Federation"**
4. The governing body shall consist of the following:

Category of governor	No. of governors in each category
Parent governors	Two
Staff governor	One
Headteacher	One
Local Authority governor	One
Co-opted governors	Four
Foundation governors	Two

5. Total number of governors: Eleven
6. Foundation governors are appointed by the York Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Parochial Church Council of the parish in which the school is situated.

- (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor *ex-officio*; The Principal Officiating Minister of the parish in which the school is situated.
- (b) The Archdeacon of Cleveland shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the *ex-officio* foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the *ex-officio* foundation

governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or where there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which his or her governorship exists.

8. The Archdeacon of Cleveland is entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint a substitute governor.
9. The ethos of the School is as follows: -

"Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers all its pupils".

10. This instrument comes into effect on 10th September 2018.

11. This instrument was made by order of North Yorkshire Local Authority on
