3. The style and location of benches and litter bins will be agreed with the Diocesan Church Buildings Adviser on behalf of the DAC.  
4. The design of the boundary railings will be agreed with the Diocesan Church Buildings Adviser on behalf of the DAC.  
5. The DAC, Registry and PCC must be added to the circulation lists for any reports which are disseminated

**Petition: To remove, clean, repair, re-lead and reinstate the West window**  
DECISION: Recommended

**I. South Milford Saint Mary** Grade II DAC 18/06/3/3/I  
**Petition: To 1. close up the North Porch arch opening with ashlar stone infill and carved stone relief, remove the stone internal plinth benches and introduce a disabled accessible WC and 2. create a level access threshold, widen the door arch opening, and introduce new internal doors to the West door**  
DECISION: Recommended  
PROVISO: The carved stone relief to the North Porch will be in accordance with design Option B 'A Curtain Moved' by Charles Gurrey with text taken from Elizabeth Jennings' poem 'Answers'

**Petition: To completely renovate the pipe organ (Forster and Andrews, Hull, 1878)**

**M. Wilberfoss Saint John the Baptist** Grade I DAC 18/06/3/3/M  
**Petition: To 1. carry out remedial works to the Nave gable, 2. take down and rebuild the gable, alter the roof structure and replace the existing arch of the Chancel, 3. carry out internal repair works to the South Aisle, 4. carry out repointing, masonry repairs and renewals where necessary to the Chancel, South Aisle and Tower, 5. lower the external ground level, regrading paths and resetting headstones where necessary, and replace perimeter gullies with Breedon gravel, 6. replace the existing rainwater goods with new cast iron rainwater goods, 7. remove the pews in the eastern half of the South Aisle and replace with Theo stackable upholstered chairs, 8. replace the existing spotlights in the Chancel with Concord Beacon LED spotlights, together with other associated minor repair and redecoration works**  
DECISION: Recommended  
PROVISOS: 1. The Specification is to be approved by an Advising Architect.  
2. Any/all excavations must be subject to an archaeological watching brief.  
3. The new chairs should not be upholstered.
