Petition: To 1. recover the Nave and Chancel roofs in lead and the North and South Aisles and South Porch roofs in terne-coated stainless steel following lead theft, 2. carry out repointing and masonry repairs to the Tower, 3. carry out improvements to the surface water drainage, 4. carry out repairs to windows, 5. shorten the longer Nave pews to the outer side of each column, retaining the shorter pews, 6. fit carpeting to the south pew platform to match the existing carpeted section of the north pew platform, 7. introduce a free-standing oak veneer heritage display cabinet in the south aisle, and 8. install a new monitored roof security system

Petition: To 1. re-site a 19th century donor board to a new position on the South wall of the nave, and 2. replace the redundant spotlight fitting on the West Door porch ceiling with a new Concord Beacon LED spotlight to illuminate the donor boards on the North wall
DECISION: Recommended

O. York Saint Olave Grade I DAC 18/07/3/1/O
Petition: To introduce an automatic chiming mechanism to the six bells and carry out maintenance works to the ringing fittings
DECISION: Recommended

P. Huggate Saint Mary Grade I DAC 18/07/3/1/P
Advice Item: To carry out a programme of internal re-ordering to 1. remove the pews and platforms in the Nave and lay new solid flooring level with the adjacent tiles, 2. introduce accessible WC facilities and storage with timber clad screens at the east ends of the Aisles, 3. relocate the font from beneath the Tower to beneath the middle arch of the South Aisle, 4. move the screen in the under-Tower area forwards to create a meeting space and install a ceiling/gallery above with spiral staircase access and a glass balustrade, and 5. extend the water supply and install foul drainage, new lighting and heating and upgrade the mains electrical supply if necessary
