

I. Lastingham Saint Mary Grade I DAC 18/09/3/1/I
Petition: To remove, conserve and re-fix the glass of windows nIII and sIII (within the Chancel) all in accordance with the recommendations of the York Glaziers Trust supplementary report of April 2018, the panels being placed in environmentally protective conditions when re-fixed.
DECISION: Recommended

J. Pickering Saint Peter and Saint Paul Grade I DAC 18/09/3/1/J
Petition: To install a new lighting scheme throughout the church together with associated electrical works
DECISION: Recommended

3.2 East Riding

A. Cottingham Saint Mary Grade I DAC 15/12/4/3/I
Petition: To introduce internet broadband equipment on the roof of the tower (four ‘sectors’, and an array on the apex of the roof), together with associated equipment and cabling, some external on the faces of the tower.

C. Bishop Burton All Saints Grade II* DAC 16/10/4/2/N
Petition: To 1. carry out re-ordering of the west end of the nave, 2. install an external access ramp to the south entrance door, 3. carry out modifications to the west door to the nave, 4. introduce a disabled-access WC at the base of the tower and kitchenette facilities adjacent to the north wall of the tower together with associated minor works, 6. relocate the bell rope, and 7. install in the churchyard a trench arch drainage system
DEFERRED

D. Flamborough Saint Oswald Grade II* DAC 17/09/3/1/J
Petition: To 1. install a gas supply pipe through the churchyard and 2. replace with a new gas fired boiler the existing electric boiler within the boiler house
DEFERRED

E. Filey Saint Oswald Grade I DAC 18/05/3/3/L
Petition: To install a defibrillator on the ~~north wall of the building adjacent to the North Porch~~ wall of the WC block in the churchyard
DECISION: Recommended

F. Sutton Park Saint Andrew Unlisted DAC 18/05/3/3/N
Petition: In the churchyard to set aside an area for the burial of cremated remains
DEFERRED

G. Brantingham All Saints Grade II* DAC 18/07/3/3/K
Petition: in the churchyard to set aside an additional area for the interment of cremated remains
DECISION: Recommended

H. Kingston Upon Hull Saint Nicholas Unlisted DAC 18/07/3/3/L
Petition: To 1. replace the existing pews with 111 chairs, 2. mount a data projector, lighting bar and stage lights to the front archway, 3. erect a retractable screen to the wall above the reredos, and 4. replace with existing sound desk housing
DEFERRED

I. Muston All Saints Grade II DAC 18/07/3/3/M
Petition: In the churchyard to erect a shed for storage of equipment
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISO: Subject to the parish confirming that the proposed location of the shed would not breach regulations regarding the minimum space to be left around oil tanks

J. Scalby Saint Laurence Grade II* DAC 18/07/3/3/N
Petition: In the “Glebe Field” to 1. set aside an area for the interment of cremated remains, and 2. in the areas presently set aside and to be set aside for the interment of cremated remains to vary the Churchyard Memorial Rules 2013 to permit, both retrospectively and in the future, the erection of upright memorials and horizontal memorials not flush with the ground
DEFERRED

K. Barmston All Saints Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/K
Petition: To introduce into the church a WWI memorial plaque (Pte. John Richard Wilson) removed from the closed church of Fraisthorpe Saint Edmund
DECISION: Recommended

L. Hessele All Saints Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/L
Petition: To replace the existing south porch doors with new part-glazed timber doors
DECISION: Recommended

M. Kingston upon Hull Holy Trinity (Hull Minster) Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/M
Petition: To restore the wiring system of the Grand Organ (Forster & Andrews/Compton)
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISOS:
1. All electrical work must be carried out by an electrician holding the current appropriate professional accreditation (at present NICEIC, NAPIT or ECA all to Full Competence).
2. The specification for the mains wiring works must be approved by the Diocesan Electrics Adviser.
3. The electrician should consider the addition of a surge diversion at the main consumer unit.

N. North Ferriby All Saints Grade II DAC 18/09/3/2/N
Petition: To 1. carry out repointing and stonework repairs and replacement to the Chancel, Vestry, North and South Aisles, North and South Porches and the Tower, 2. repair and reinstate the Vestry and Aisle roof material, 3. redecorate the Chancel and Vestry interior walls, 4. carry out repairs to floor tiles and 5. carry out minor repairs to window glazing
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISO: The specification and drawings must be approved by an Advising Architect

O. Seamer Saint Martin Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/O
Petition: In the churchyard to rebuild a 4.5 m length of the eastern churchyard wall (Interim Faculty dated 9th April 2018)
DECISION: Recommended

P. Walkington All Hallows Grade II* DAC 18/09/3/2/P
Petition: On land to the south of the church to create an area of off-road parking with access to the public highway
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISO: Any/all excavations must be subject to an archaeological watching brief.

Q. Wawne Saint Peter Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/Q
Petition: In the churchyard to clean the War Memorial and add a memorial plaque to Sgt. Arthur Bromby
DEFERRED

R. Welton Saint Helen Grade II* DAC 18/09/3/2/R
Petition: To remove the hands, dismantle and clean the dial motion works, reinstate the same and overhaul the pulleys of the clock (William Potts of Leeds, 1921)
DECISION: Recommended

S. Bewholme Saint John Unlisted DAC 18/09/3/2/S
Petition: To. 1. introduce 8 additional LED wall lights and carry out associated electrical works and 2. replace the carpet in the church
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISO: The Lighting Advisor must agree the type of fittings to be used

T. Burton Pidsea Saint Peter Grade I DAC 18/09/3/2/T
Petition: To carry out improvements and additions to the existing electric heating system
DECISION: Recommended

J. Saxton All Saints Grade I DAC 18/09/3/3/J
Petition: To permit the installation of a replacement canopy on the side of the school building which forms part of the churchyard boundary
DECISION: Recommended

K. Stamford Bridge Saint John the Baptist Unlisted DAC 18/09/3/3/K
Petition: To 1. carry out repointing to the Bellcote and to the North Nave wall and 2. in the churchyard replace the church noticeboard frame
DECISION: Recommended

L. Newton Kyme Saint Andrew Grade I DAC 18/09/3/3/L
Petition: To carry out repairs to and modify the existing boiler house including rebuilding the existing stone slate roof, replace the existing oil storage tank with a new bunded tank, replace the existing oil fired boiler with a new boiler, replace the existing radiators with new high output radiators and renew pipework where necessary
DECISION: Recommended
PROVISO: The contractor's quote and specification must be submitted to the Diocesan Heating Advisor for approval
