- 12 Jesus asked them to come and eat. None of the disciples asked, 'Who are you?' They knew it was the Lord. This was the third time Jesus appeared to the disciples after He rose from the dead.

- 13 After eating Jesus asked Peter, 'Do you love me more than these others?' 'Yes Lord you know that I love you,' Peter replied. 'Feed my lambs,' said Jesus.





'Feed my sheep,' said Jesus.





Jesus said this to explain how Peter would give his life for the gospel.




