Craft Resources

Today's craft is making a paper-plate basket with fish and bread in to help families re-tell the story of Jesus feeding over 5000 people

Per family: 1 x paper bag, 1 x Instruction sheet

Per basket: 2 x paper plates, 1 x coloured card to make bread, 1 x coloured card to make fish

Extra Resources for bags

- A bag of popcorn kernels and instructions
- Picture of five loaves and two fishes for prayer
- Today's symbol

Extra Ideas

- Invite families to a socially distanced picnic in the church grounds or a local park where there is enough space. Encourage them to bring something to do with fish and/or bread
- Number trail. Set up a trail around the church grounds or village. The children have to work out the answers for each clue and then add them all up
