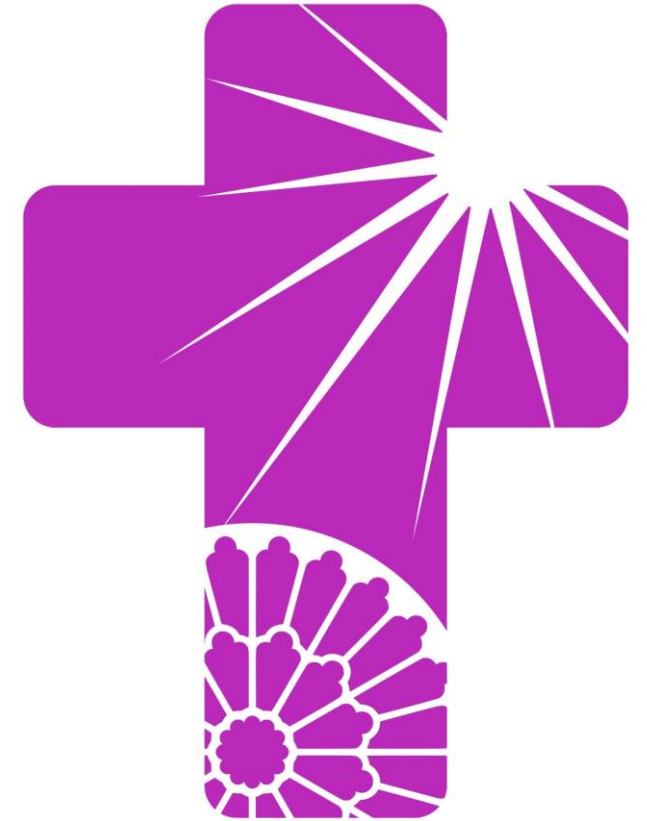




BETRAYED

Peter denies Jesus

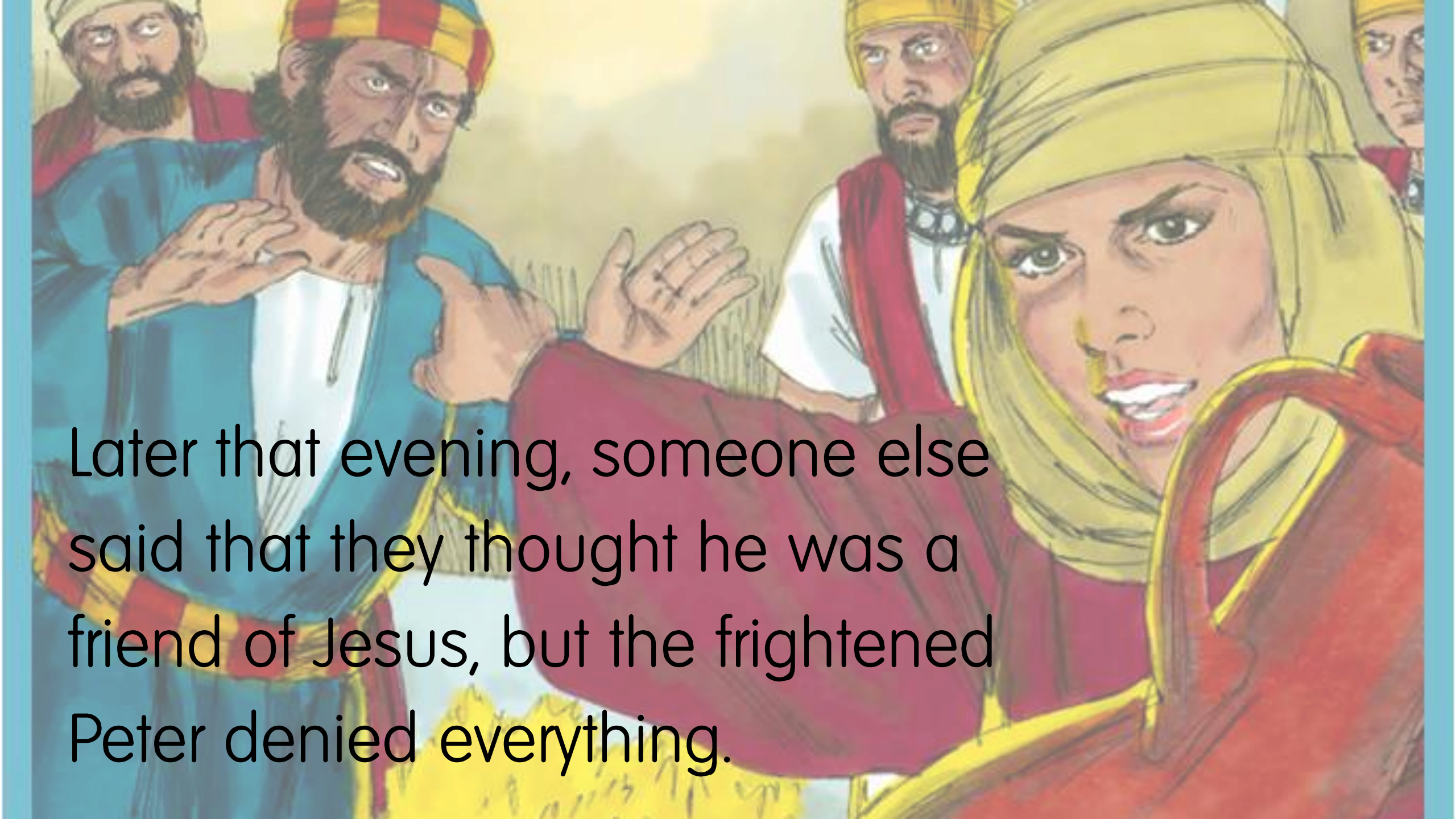

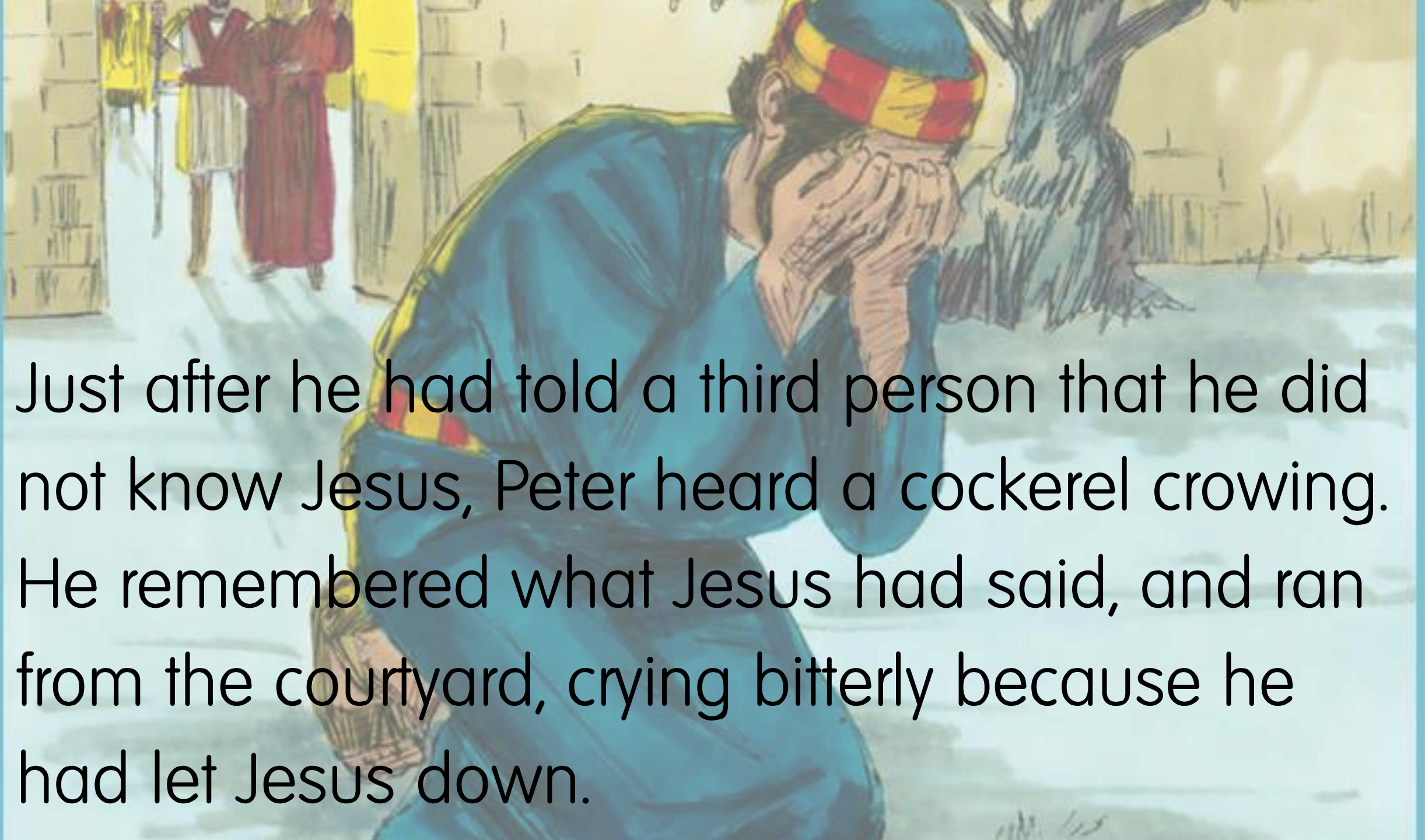
Jesus was taken to the house of the Chief Priest Caiaphas, where people said things about him that weren't true.
