Which bit of the picture would you change to show your own understanding of the story?

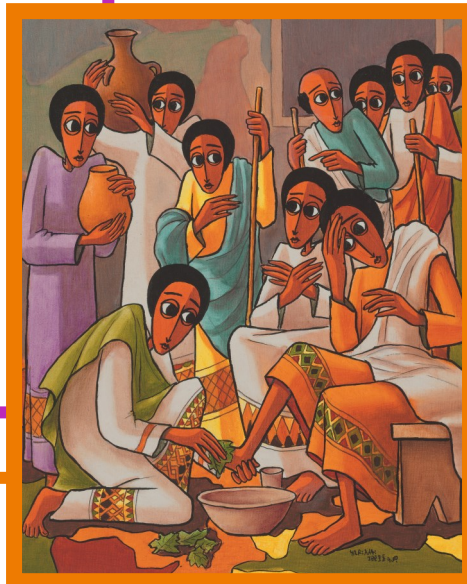
# THINK

# TALK

The night that Jesus and his friends celebrated the Passover Festival he got up from the table, took off his robe and wrapped a towel around his waist. He started to wash the disciples dirty, smelly feet just as a servant would normally do. Peter didn't want his feet washed until he realised that it was an important part of what Jesus wanted to show them about belonging to him. He told the disciples that his followers should show that they love him by serving those around them just as he had served them.
