

LISTEN

This story comes from John Chapter 13 verses 1-20 in the Bible. It is about Jesus showing the disciples how important it was to serve one another with love by washing their feet.

SERVE

Jesus washes the disciples feet



Play a memory game. The first person says 'I am going to serve...' and names another person in the group and what they could do for them e.g. 'I am going to serve Bob by brushing his hair'. The named person then responds introducing a new person's name and the first act of service and then adding another e.g. 'I am going to serve Tilly by brushing her hair, and making her a sandwich'. Keep going until everyone has had a turn or you run out of ideas

What can you do to show other people that you love them?

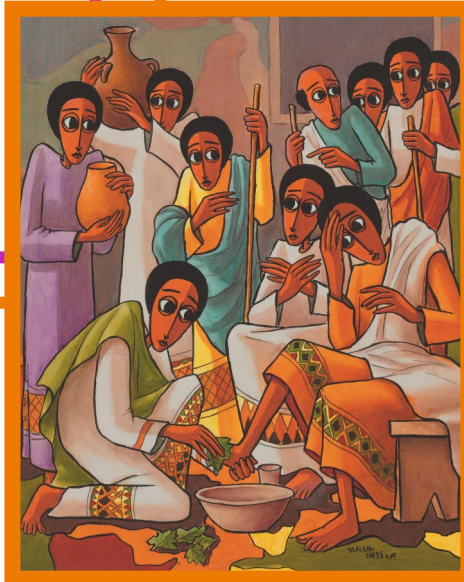
How might you put those ideas into action?
