

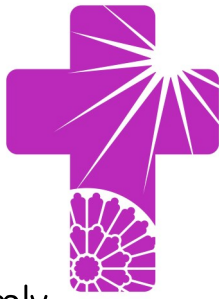

Jesus dies on the cross

The soldiers used dice to randomly decide who could have Jesus' robe when he died. Find two dice and decide on random activities—one for each number—e.g. find a sock, sing a nursery rhyme, stand on one leg for 20 seconds, etc.

PLAY

Allocate a number to each person in the group.

Roll the dice—two people can then race to complete a task. i.e. roll 4 and 6, person 4 does task 6 and person 6 does task 4!

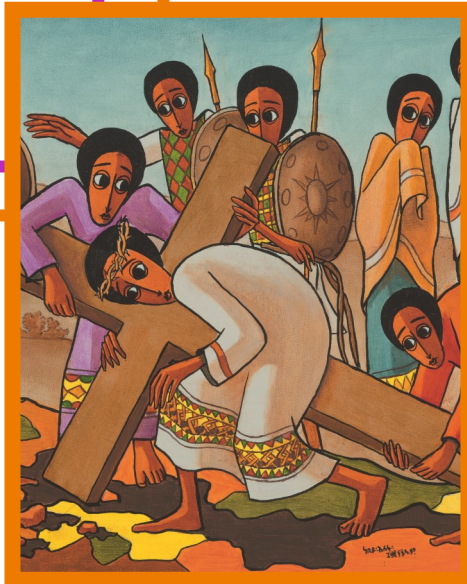
What is the saddest thing that has happened in your life?
