WHAT IS GROW?

Whether you are part of a large thriving youth group, or the only young person connected with your church, GROW is about investing in young people (11-16) as disciples of Jesus. Why don't you join in?

Together we explore themes of faith through prayer, scripture, love, generosity, worship, sharing faith, rest and joy. Through small group discussion and activities, young people will grow in their discipleship, deeply rooted in how we each Live Christ's Story.

At the end of the year, young people are invited to become Youth Discipleship Ambassadors, both in the parish and the wider diocese, enabled to be more involved in the life of the church.



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WHERE AND WHEN?

Monthly sessions, lead by Youth Workers from across the diocese, take place on weekday evening from January to November 2025, with a weekend in April (25-27th) and an invitation to a special service in York Minster in January 2026.

Gathered sessions will be hosted by five deaneries across the diocese:

- York (Tuesdays)
- Stokesley
- Southern Ryedale
- North Holderness (Thursdays)
- Scarborough (Tuesdays)
