

## PRAY

As you point to each finger on one hand name a person that you love. If you think you have let that person down by saying something unkind or not helping them as they asked bend that finger down.

We can let people we love down in all sorts of ways sometimes through laziness or by putting ourselves first, sometimes through fear, like Peter. When we say sorry God forgives us. He can also help us to say sorry to others and forgive them when they let us down.

If the finger representing someone is straight then thank God and ask him to help you not let that person down in the future. If it is bent, as you say sorry to God straighten your finger. When you have finished praying wiggle your fingers and thank God for all of those people to love and be loved by.
